## — ARTIST'S STATEMENT —

Ireland is where God reaches out to me the most through His stillness, beauty, overall Creations and Colors. The photo was taken in the Black Valley of the Gap of Dunloe, in County Kerry, Ireland. The lone sheep, knowing that his Shepherd, though not seen, is near, is protected as he eats in the valley, near the still water of the River Loe.

Sheep don't always herd together, but rather know that they are safe within their areas, just as we are safe within our Shepherd's area of Love. The sheep in Ireland are painted with a special paint to identify them to the other ranchers/shepherds in the area, as opposed to having physical fences to divide the range areas. The paint washes out during the shearing process and doesn't harm the wool. — *Ginny Wisley*
