JUNE/JULY CONSTRUCTION & REBUILDING; In the mid-80s the Koskys arrived in the Republic of Transkei holding a Bible in one hand and a toolbox in the other. The government was so grateful for the work that Kelly & Kathy were doing that they gave the ministry a large plot of land to build the main mission station in Gatyana. The Koskys would preach at night and construct the main mission station during the day. They had little money but a big vision to build a mission station that would be a training center and Bible college. After 10 years of hard work, the mission station was fully operational. But, over the last 25 years, the mission station has required a lot of repairs. In June/July 2024 we are recruiting a team of workers (men & women)from America to come to Africa and help restore the mission station. NO INCOME TAX on STOCK SALES, If you own stocks or investments and sell them at a profit, you would normally pay income tax to the IRS on your gain. Now you can donate your stock or investments to the ministries and DO **NOT** HAVE TO PAY INCOME TAX on the gains. But you can deduct the full higher increased value of the stocks as a charitable donation. By doing a DST you do **not** have to pay any income tax on your investment gain, but you are able to deduct the full increased value as a charitable deduction. He finally made the break this year and resigned as a military officer; and has volunteered to serve the Lord as the new dean of our Bible college. We are honored and excited to having this Godly man with his leadership giftings and qualifications to work with us, as we have a shared vision to train up the future generations of Christian leaders at our Bible college.
