

Pentecost is celebrated 50 days after Easter Sunday. The term Pentecost comes from Greek meaning "fiftieth". The Day of Pentecost is the climax of the Great Fifty Days of Easter, celebrating as it does the gift of the Spirit to the body of Christ — the church.
